

The Frail Non-Disabled (FiND) Questionnaire identifies frail older persons without mobility disability living in the community.

Interpretation	The FiND questionnaire consists of five questions: two are specifically aimed at identifying individuals with mobility disability, and three assess components of the frailty syndrome: weight loss, exhaustion and sedentary behavior.
